### Who is this for?

- Disabled
- Neurodivergent



It includes people working in:

- production management
- editorial
- craft
- technical roles
- scripted and unscripted.



You can apply if:

- You have been working in TV for at least three years and have been promoted.
- You have been in your current job for at least 18 months
- You can show you have the skills to move on to the next stage of your career with support.





- You have faced barriers around attitudes, access or lack of support.



- You live in the UK.



### What is involved?

The mentoring will be online over Zoom:

- 6 sessions with a mentor
- 3 group sessions
- 6 training sessions



It is run by [TripleC DANC](#) with Channel 4.

There are 6 places.

You will get you a **mentor**.

A **mentor** helps you learn new skills and network with new people.

They help your career.





Your mentor will be picked based on your needs and goals.



The aim is for people to be in a better place to move on in their career by the end.



RISE will run for 9 months from April to December 2022.



We will meet your access needs.



The mentoring is free and you will be paid for your time.

4. Your current job



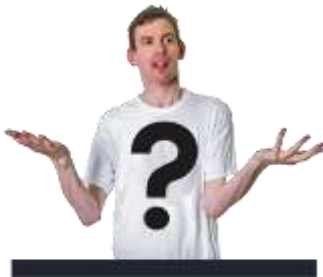

11. What would you like to be doing in two years' time?

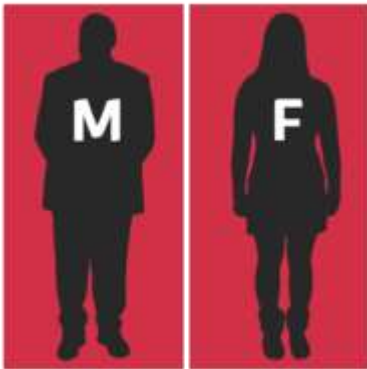

14. Is your gender different from the gender you were assigned at birth?



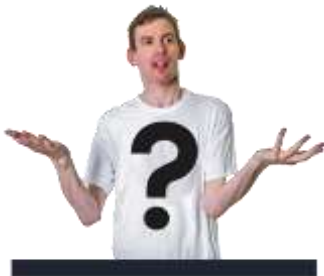
