- 6 sessions with a mentor
- 3 group sessions
- 4 training sessions




The project is run by [TripleC DANC](#) with Channel 4.

RISE4 will run from July 2026 to March 2027.



We will meet your access needs.



It is free and you will be paid £70 for each session except skills sessions.



Who is this for?

This is for people who work in TV behind the camera who are:

- Deaf
- Disabled
- Neurodivergent



It includes people working in:

- production management
- editorial
- craft
- technical roles
- scripted and unscripted.



You can apply if:

- You have been working in TV for at least 3 years and have 4 or more credits.
- You have already been promoted.
- You have been in your current job for at least 18 months
- You can show you have the skills to move on with your career with support.





- You have faced barriers around attitudes, access or lack of support.



- You live in the UK.
